This Addendum forms a part of, and modifies, the Bidding Documents for the above referenced project, dated March 25, 2026. Acknowledge the receipt of this Addendum No. 3 and all subsequent Addenda, if any, in the space provided on the Bid Form. Failure to do so may subject Bid to disqualification.

General:

Clarifications:

- Item 1. As stated in the Project Manual, the gate count which correlates with the updated drawings included for the Base Bid includes 2 – 16’ horse gates and 3 – 12’ horse gates. The gate count for Alternate #1 includes 1 – 16’ horse gate. The gate count for Alternate #2 includes 6 – 12’ horse gates. No gates are included in Alternate #3.

- Item 2. All shrubs and trees along the fence line in the Base Bid along the driveway are to be removed. Any potentially useful shade trees may be left at the discretion of both the Contractor and Project Manager. Usable shade trees along the fencing located on the interior of the field shall be left for shade. All shrubs and trees along the fence line in Alternate #1 along the driveway and west side of the pasture are to be removed. Any potentially useful shade trees may be left at the discretion of both the Contractor and Project Manager. All cleared/under-brushed areas are to be left cleaned and graded with no holes or debris left in the pastures due to the safety of the livestock.

- Item3. As stated in the Project Manual, all gates are to be fastened when closed with hardware designed to secure the gate without a chain or additional assistance. Hardware to be approved by the project manager. Entry gate and assembly are included in the Base Bid. Entry gate automatic opening system is to be removed by the contractor. Replacement and installation will not be included in this project.
- Item 3. As stated in the Project Manual, all measurements/dimensions provided in the project manual and drawings are approximate and not to be used by the contractor for their bids. It is the responsibility of the contractor to verify all dimensions, gate counts, information needed for the base bid and each alternate, including all underground utilities.
